Quality, Pricing & Product News:

- Romaine:** D'Arrigo Farm (Andy Boy Label) Petite Romaine Heart prices projected to be 25% lower by mid-week, a new seasonal low!
- Brentwood Corn Alert!** Supplies are tightening on White Corn & prices are up as the season is ending in just a few weeks. Yellow Corn has ended from CA & the new, OR grown crop has started. Prices are reasonable with good quality.
- Lime Alert!** MX grown Lime supplies have tightened with rising prices weekly. Rain in the growing area has limited harvest for several weeks now. Relief expected in about 3 weeks.
- Heirloom Tomatoes:** Supplies on all Heirloom Tomatoes from Comanche Creek remain very limited. A small heat wave in late August caused blossom drop & we're in a major gap between ripe & green turning fruit. We're only receiving a very small amount of #1 & #2 grade Mixed Heirlooms at this point. We're still filling in with Coke, Riverdog & Landerosa Farms Mixed Heirlooms as well as conventional Heirlooms from Valdivia Farm in the San Diego area for the remainder of the local season. The Organic Mixed Heirlooms are purchased & sold under the #2, choice-grade. Organic Caprese Tomato supplies are limited as well this week.
- Pumpkins:** We'll start bringing Pumpkins in early this year! All sizes & varieties will be on hand on Friday 9/13/19.
- Brussels Sprouts:** Time to switch to local, hand-picked Sprouts, just in from Half Moon Bay; supply will be tight on a strong market for about 2 weeks until volume increases.
- CA Veggie Update:** Supplies of English Cucumbers are starting to improve but prices remain on the high side. Price relief still a couple of weeks to a month away. Using 16ct Canadian to fill the CA grown gap. Eggplant, Red & Yellow Bells, Yellow Straightneck & Zucchini supplies are easing a bit but prices also remain on the high side.
- Organic Baby Turnips:** Remain very limited & subject to gapping as we await the new, local crops soon to start. Offerings lately have poor quality roots & yellowing tops.
- Broccoli/Cauliflower:** Higher than normal heat & humidity is causing quality issues with both. Broccoli Crowns are more affected than bunched, & prices are increasing daily. Cauliflower market is rising after being down the past few weeks. Back to using mostly 16's but still using some 12's as needed. Both Broccoli & Cauliflower markets expected to be strong for at least several weeks.
- Lemon Grass:** Market remains hot, but is starting to come off as the crop is finally recovering some from super high heat in the recent past, plus successive planting gaps.
- Persian Cucumbers:** Still a hot market caused by heat.
