Quality and Product News:

Avocados: Harvest in MX is expected to be heavy, but new challenge is trucking delayed at the MX border. Expecting CA supply to improve, especially with high market price.

Brocolini: Supplies are still very limited but is starting to improve. Shortage caused by bad weather in NorCal, SoCal & MX. We have Sweet Baby Broccoli to cover sales.

Onions: ID & WA State are running out of storage Red, White & Yellow Onions for the season. Prices have almost doubled from last week & we expect prices to continue to rise until they finish with Northwest grown Onions. It appears that the MX/TX grown Onions had major damage & will not be able to supply the industry this season. Next projected area in Imperial County is expecting a light crop because of reduced plantings.

Ramps: Season just starting up in Ohio. Their season should run for another 10 days & then we'll source from Michigan.

Price Alerts:

Celery: Short this week on a strong market. Yuma is done & Oxnard is still seeing supply gaps and quality issues from the rain this season. Product is very tight. Hearing it will stay strong through mid-June.

Red Bell Peppers: Supplies have tightened as the Nogales season is winding down. All colors are limited but the Red has taken a huge swing up.
